



# Back-to-School Supply Program

The Okotoks Healthy Family Resource Centre has a program that will assist families with the cost of school supplies.

- Depending upon the school attended, families will either:
- be provided with a Staples gift card to purchase supplies (distribution August 15-19)
  - OR**
  - have their school supply fee paid to the school their child attends.

**Who can access the funding?** Parents of students in kindergarten – grade 12 who attend school in Okotoks, DeWinton, Black Diamond, or Turner Valley, **and** who meet the income guidelines (see table) to receive the Alberta Child Health Benefit.

\* Exceptional circumstances may be considered.

\$29,073	Single parent with 2 children
\$34,056	Single parent with 3 children
\$39,336	Single parent with 4 children
\$29,285	Couple with 1 child

\$44,000	Couple with 4 children

**How do I register?** You must contact the Resource Centre between **June 15 and August 12 2011** \* and provide:

- proof of Alberta Child Health Benefit coverage or your 2010 tax Notice of Assessment
- contact information
- your child's name, grade, and school attended
- written permission for the Resource Centre to contact your child's school to verify registration and/or arrange payment for the supply fee.

\*the program has a limited budget. Early registration is encouraged to guarantee funding
